



THE ABORIGINAL COUNCIL OF WINNIPEG NOTICE OF ELECTION AND ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The Aboriginal Council of Winnipeg will hold its Elections and Annual General Meeting on October 14th and October 15th 2014

Elections

The Council has an elected Board of ten members. Vacancies to be filled: three (3) three-year term for position of Director and one (1) three-year term for position of President.

A candidate running for the office of Director must be a voting member and must:

- **Be Aboriginal**
- **Be 16 years and over**
- **Have resided in the City of Winnipeg for a period of six (6) months by election date. (Proof required)**

TO QUALIFY AS A CANDIDATE FOR THE OFFICE OF DIRECTOR AND PRESIDENT, THE CANDIDATE SHALL:

- **FOR DIRECTOR POSITION: Present original nomination papers, supplied by the Council in support of his/her candidacy which bears the signatures of twenty-five (25) voting members,**
- **FOR PRESIDENT POSITION: Present original nomination papers, supplied by the Council in support of his/her candidacy which bears the signatures of fifty (50) voting members,**
- **FOR BOTH POSITIONS: Present the said nomination papers to the office of the Chief Electoral Officer no later than seven (7) days prior to the election,**

Voting will take place on October 14th, 2014 from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm.

Interested individuals can pick up their nomination papers as of September 22nd, 2014 at the Council's office in Room 112-181 Higgins Ave and a copy of the Council's By-Law to verify the requirements to run for the office of Director.

The Chief Electoral Officer will announce the results of the election of Directors during the business portion of the Council's AGM on October 15th, 2014 from 11:30 am – 2:00 pm.
